

REGULATIONS CONCERNING A RIGHT OF BURIAL GRAVE SPACE

(Incorporating Cemetery Regulations)

PRIVATE GRAVES

The fee having been paid at the time of burial, now grants exclusive Rights of Burial in the numbered plot for 50 years, providing the cemetery regulations in entirety are observed and those below in particular.

1. If a grave is to be used for the burial of any person other than the original holder of the Right of Burial then a signed letter written by the holder of those rights must be delivered to the Cemetery Superintendent at least 24 hours before the grave is dug.
2. The grave space may be transferred to another person only with the written consent of the holder of Right of Burial, in a signed letter to the Cemetery Superintendent giving the name and address of the new holder of the holder of Right of Burial. The Cemetery will then hold this agreement valid. This agreement becomes void if the holder fails to register the transfer with Woodgrange Park Cemetery within 28 days of any transfer, or attempts, or does sell the grave space to any other person. The acceptance of transfer of ownership of "Right of Burial" does not imply, accept or acknowledge the applicants rights to the grave, nor does it grant the restitution of those rights under the Cemetery regulations.
3. If a memorial stone is not erected on the grave within twelve months this grant will become void. Permission must be obtained before any memorial can be erected; the Directors reserve the right to remove any items placed on the grave without permission. No memorial can be installed that is over 3 feet high. Grave surrounds can be purchased from Woodgrange Park Cemetery Ltd. No other surrounds including temporary surrounds are permitted and will be removed.
4. Insurance cover for all memorial stones must be taken out. The Directors have the right of passage over all plots and may temporarily cover or remove a memorial, without notice, for any necessary purpose.
5. It is incumbent upon the holders of the Right of Burial to keep the same in good repair, but if allowed to fall into decay; the Directors as representatives (or custodians) of the Cemetery Estate reserve the right to remove, without notice, any broken or damaged monument, overgrown or decayed shrubs, or plants. If it is necessary for such action to be implemented, or the grave has been unattended or neglected for the period of one year and one day, this grant will become void. No plants must be allowed to grow taller than 3 feet and wider than the grave width.
6. The holders of Right of Burial are to act in all respects, in a sober, responsible manner, with due consideration to the other holders of Rights of Burial of Burial, the employees of the Cemetery and members of the public, whilst in the Cemetery grounds, and any breach of the regulations, will entitle the Directors to refuse access to the Cemetery
7. The Directors reserve the right (unconditionally) to refuse access to the Cemetery.
8. The Directors of the Cemetery do not accept any liability for any damage to property or injury to persons, however occasioned whilst the holder of Right of Burial, their representative or members of the public are on or attending the Cemetery.
9. This agreement does not convey or grant any rights or obligations other than those contained in the Deed of Rights of Burial, subject to the regulations in force from time to time, and to such fees as may be payable, by order of the Directors.
10. The Company does not hold itself responsible for any accidents to tombs, monuments or gravestones occasioned by storms, wind, lightening or other cause. It is the duty of those acquiring 'Right of Burial' to keep the grave and all things appertaining thereto in good order and repair and if allowed to fall into decay the custodians of the Cemetery reserve the right to remove, without notice, and at the cost of the holder of the "Right of Burial", any broken or damaged monuments, headstones or overgrown or decayed shrubs or plants and to dispose of the same without notice.
11. The taking of photographs, video or video recordings are strictly forbidden.
